

Phenology: flowering May to June; seed development and dispersal July to early September.

Management Responsibility: BLM (AZ Strip Field Office), Navajo Nation.

Similar Species: *A. welshii* is distinguished from other milkweeds by its large seeds, spreading to pendulous follicles and cottony-pubescent pedicles.

Notes: few fruits develop; propagates mostly from rhizomes. Juvenile resembles *A. cutleri* Woodson.
