

Asteraceae (Surmower Farmly

Phenology: flowering July to September.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coconino NF).

Similar Species: Cirsium parryi ssp. parryi has yellowish-white flowers

and sinuately toothed to sinuately lobed leaves.

Notes: first discovered 7/7/87, very little is known about the taxon. Browsing by ungulates has sometimes been noted as well as the presence of the introduced bull thistle (*Cirsium vulgare*) nearby in the drainage.
