

Apocynaceae (Dogbane Family)

Phenology: flowering April and May; fruiting May and June.

Management Responsibility: BLM (AZ Strip Field Office).

Synonym: Cycladenia jonesii (Eastwood), Welsh & Atwood

Similar Species: a montane California taxon, C. h. venusta has longer

petioles.

Notes: BLM has monitored Arizona populations since 1993. There

appears to be no viable seed production.

Habitat: on saline soils on the Chinle Formation in cool desert shrub and juniper communities between 4,400-6,000 ft (1340-1830 m) elevation.







Range: Woodbury Canyon and Potter Canyon; also found in Utah.
