

Polygonaceae (Knotweed/Buckwheat Family)

Phenology: plants usually leafless when flowering and fruiting (September through November).

Management Responsibility: San Carlos Tribe, AZ Dept of Transportation.

Similar Species: no other shrubby *Eriogonum* occurs on gypsum outcrops in Graham County.

Notes: species has limited distribution; associated with *Purshia subintegra*, a federally listed species.




Eriogonum apachense
