
## ROUNDLEAF ERRAZURIZIA



Habitat: occurs in exposed sites in several types of outcrops ranging from sandy soils in sandstone, gravelly soils in calcareous outcrops, to deep, alluvial cinders in sandstone breaks; desertscrub, elevation 4,800-5,200 ft (1460-1585 m).





**Range:** Little Colorado River drainage.
