

Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

Phenology: flowers June through September.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF), DoD-US Army (Ft. Huachuca).

Notes: the description of *H. pringlei* in McVaugh would also include the Latin American species of *H. jaliscense* and *H. stuposum*, extending the entire range of the species to Guatemala. The taxonomic question as to the true identity of the species remains unresolved.

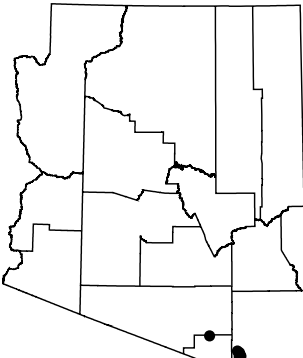

Habitat: seems to be associated with pine oak forests, found on steep slopes and ridges and stable terraces in canyon bottoms, 6,000-7,500 ft (1830-2285 m) elevation.
