*Euphorbiaceae (Spurge Family)*

Phenology: flowers July to August.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF), possibly private.

Similar Species: differs from *Jatropha macrorrhiza* by flowers with petals absent, leaves round-lobed and not toothed, and from *M. angustiloba* by its broad terminal leaf lobes.

Notes: possibly conspecific with *M. chlorosticta* by Wiggins (1964), and its difference from *M. angustiloba* is minimal.

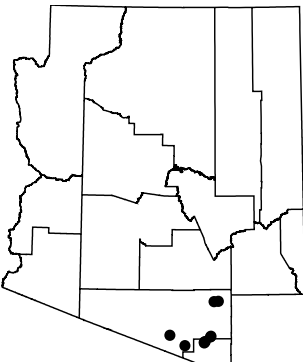
