

Scrophulariaceae (Snapdragon Family)

Phenology: flowers in June-July, fruiting in August.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF), BLM (Safford Field Office).

Notes: some populations threatened by rock climbers. Monitored population in the Santa Catalinas has been stable

Penstemon discolor



Habitat: bedrock openings in chaparral or pine-oak woodland at 4,400-7,200 ft (1340-2200 m) elevation. Plants rooted in rock cracks or thin soil pockets on granite bedrock or outcroppings of whitish volcanic tuff.
