

Phenology: flowering May; fruiting May to June.

Management Responsibility: BLM (AZ Strip Field Office).

**Notes:** locally common but highly restricted; impacted by rabbit herbivory. BLM monitoring 1987-1998 indicates mostly stable to upward trend.

Habitat: typically in gravelly Kaibab limestone on mesa tops in pinyon-juniper woodlands, but also known from steep north facing canyon slopes of Supai Formation in Mohave desertscrub, 3,900 to 5,200 ft (1190-1585 m) elevation.
